Mayor Ekstrand opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m.

The following topics were discussed:

- Resident complained about fireworks at 4th of July. “Fireworks prohibited” will be added to the block party permit, also specifying that permits will be revoked and future permits will not be issued – need wording from Attorney DeBellis.
- Manny from Lithology – wants to put up a dunk tank at Music on Main beginning July 27. Another option mentioned was a hammer hitting bell (to test strength). The Board wants the hammer and not the dunk tank, with proper permit and insurance.
- Regularly scheduled business items – make revisions to June 5th minutes.
- Tonight’s public hearings/Hearings to be scheduled
- Complete Flushing Bank Water Account paperwork
- Fire Department
- Building Department:
 - Property maintenance issues – 2 houses on the south side of Route 109, west of Staples St.
 - Notification requirements for all Special Use Permits, Zone Changes, etc. – Require signage on the property and 200’ radius notification of property owners
- Highway Department – Tree issues at 228 Van Cott Ave. and 65 William St., Superintendent Fisch will investigate
- Water Department: Status report on generator upgrades and High Pressure Zone installation is 80% complete
