**RESOLVED (#2018-09-14)**, to approve the use of up to 6 Village Department of Public Works vehicles by the Fire Department for the Columbus Day weekend street fair on Saturday, October 8<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, October 9<sup>th</sup> in order to block Main Street to keep pedestrians attending the fair safe. The trucks will be placed at the intersections of Main Street & South Front Street and Main Street & Prospect Street.
