USE OF FACILITIES – Upon a motion made by Trustee Parisi and seconded by Trustee Priestley, it was unanimously,

RESOLVED (#2022-10-18), to approve a request from Elizabeth Gardens for the use of the Courtroom for their annual shareholder's meeting. There could be between 50-60 people in attendance, possibly less.

 - o General discussion about the annual installation dinner
 - o \$200,000 grant for the ambulance all grant paperwork has been filed with DASNY
 - \$150,000 grant for gators waiting for paperwork from Mike DiBartolo and DASNY
- Building Department:

 - o Schmeltzer/Rte. 109 in court, given 30 days for wall paperwork, due back in court in 30 days set for trial for property maintenance

 - o Phoenix Eastern Medical grass mowed on Heisser Lane
 - Car repair and gas station for mini mart and car repair need special use permits, also need a Spanish interpreter

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- o New application received for the former tanning salon/Burgerology
- o Barton's Liquors no new info
- o Avanti approximately 6-8 weeks to complete the building
- O Robbie Lee property delay as IDA hasn't transferred tax exempt rights to new owner. Robbie Lee successor needs to clear the property.

- o Sprinkler repairs at 34 Hill Rd. and Whiskey Down walkway
- o Routine maintenance of parking lots and Main Street
- o Painting parking lot STOP and stop bars in Parking Lot 5
- O All hanging baskets removed along with plants from the fountain in Village Green. Flower pots remain.
