The following topics were discussed:

- Regularly scheduled business items:
 - No changes to minutes.
 - Laundromat tax certiorari to be held for more information.
- Tonight's public hearings/Hearings to be scheduled:
 - Fairfield fountains – will this run all year long?
- Fire Department:
 - Don't think they will be holding any parties during the balance of this year.
- Building Department:
 - St. Luke's is doing major interior renovations and installing a sprinkler system in the old bank property.
 - Still waiting for approval from the Fire Marshal for 37 Potter St. – the Fire Marshal has been backlogged.
 - Waiting for application for assisted living facility.
- Highway Department:
 - Working on finishing up the Main Street paving project.
 - Tree and branches came down in the storm.

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- Deputy Mayor Barrett asked about the trees in Village Green. Superintendent Fellman stated that all three large trees need to be removed. The Board asked that Stapleton report on the status of the trees and their opinion on the salvageability of the trees.
- Water Department:
 - Water tank is moving along. There was a discussion on cell tower installations on the new tank so specs for bid can be produced. Four cell tower installations would be the max.
- Code Department:
 - Administrator Harty will follow up on ID badges with Diane Menig.
